

Ride a Donated Bike Across Peru

We have a selection of nice bikes in assorted sizes that have been rebuilt with low gears for crossing the Andes Mountains. Gearing with 34 tooth chainrings and 28 tooth rear cogs or equivalent are typical on these bikes. Most of the bikes have bar-end or down tube shifting. The bikes have been overhauled to be reliable for crossing the remote region of Peru. New chains, cogs, tires and tubes have been installed to make the bikes low maintenance.

Your bike will be shipped to you six weeks before the tour so you can add your own saddle and pedals. You are responsible for transporting your bike to Peru when you fly to Lima. At the end of the tour, the bikes will be donated as race prizes at the Gringo Race the weekend following the tour.
